**USASAC POLICY STATEMENT NUMBER: 102.5**

**SUBJECT:** Foreign Disclosure Office (FDO) Staffing Requirements.

**POLICY:** The U.S. Army Security Assistance Command-Alexandria (USASAC) Security Officer serves as USASAC's FDO with responsibility for reviewing and authorizing the release of all Delegation of Disclosure Authority Letters (DDLs), Exceptions to the National Disclosure Policy (ENDPs) and first time requests for the release of major defense equipment (MDE). In addition, certain requests for information may also require FDO review and release approval. Such requests for Release of Information will be processed in accordance with paragraphs 3-4a(2) and 3-4c(1) of Army Regulation (AR) 380-10. The USASAC FDO will obtain any required coordination from Headquarters, U.S. Army Materiel Command, Deputy Chief of Staff for Intelligence (AMXMI-SCM).

**DISCUSSION:** The DDLs, ENDPs, MDE releases and the country's request for the release of information must be handled expeditiously. Prior to their release, DDLs, ENDPs and MDE requests must be staffed with and approved by the USASAC FDO. Necessary in-house coordinations will be obtained from appropriate organizations by the FDO. These could include the appropriate regional directorate, the USASAC Legal Advisor, the Office of International Industrial Cooperation and the Operations and Logistics Directorate. Other requests for information received from foreign governments will be processed in accordance with the cited paragraphs of AR 380-10.
