**USASAC POLICY STATEMENT NUMBER: 106.2**

**SUBJECT:** Foreign Gifts

**POLICY:**

a. Army employees and their families are restricted from accepting personal gifts from foreign officials of more than \$200.00 unless non-acceptance will cause potential embarrassment to the U.S. Government or the foreign government offering the gift.

b. Personnel receiving gifts from foreign officials will provide the gift(s) to the USASAC Protocol Officer in the Administration and Security Division (AMSAC-SA) who will coordinate with the AMC Ethics Counselor to determine if it may be retained by the individual or if it must be turned over to the command for disposition. See AMC Regulation 632-2 for procedures.

c. Solicitation of gifts is strictly prohibited.

d. All gifts from foreign officials or governments must be offered unconditionally (no limitation as to use or ownership).

**DISCUSSION:** Acceptance of a foreign gift of more than \$200.00 in value by an Army employee and/or the employee's family member(s) for personal use is a violation of Federal Law. Directors are required to ensure that all personnel are appraised of this policy at least annually.
