SUBJECT: Guidance for Transfer of Night Vision Devices (USASAC Policy 03-06)

1. Reference Defense Security Cooperation Agency, Policy Memorandum 03-19, 24 Nov 03, subject as above with attachments.
2. Reference memorandum is forwarded for your action. The policy is designed to facilitate the transfer of Night Vision Devices (NVD) and systems to allied and friendly countries through Foreign Military Sales (FMS) and Direct Commercial Sales (DCS), while protecting U.S. forces as well as critical production and manufacturing technology.
3. The memorandum indicates that the Defense Technology Security Administration (DTSA) has overall responsibility for the formulation and management of NVD export policy.
4. It also clarifies the requirements for all transfers of NVD. It provides the required physical security and accountability note for NVD transfers and clarifies when this note will be used.
5. This guidance is not retroactive. There is no need to do amendments or modifications to add the NVD note.
